General Updates

- Our Chapter size has grown to about 100 brothers
- The COVID-19 Pandemic has suspended all on-campus activity at Clemson, and therefore all Chapter activities are suspended for the time being
- The Executive Council is working remotely to continue maintaining administrative work

House Updates

- Our house, located in Seneca, has and is still going through major improvements
 - o The two bathrooms on the second floor have been completely re-done
 - o The two pillars in the front of the house have been replaced by four larger, stone pillars
 - o Lights have been installed to shine up on the pillars, and are able to change colors
 - o Blacked out windows have been placed on the first floor outside of the current wooden boards to provide a better appearance from the outside
 - o The kitchen cabinets and counter have been re-done, along with the kitchen sink
 - o The entire second floor has been replaced with hardwood
- We still have a hall on the Greek Quad, which holds 10 brothers and a common room, accessible to all brothers with CUID
